

Case performed by Dr. Feriduni – 6209 FU in 2 procedures

FUE's performed on a 49-year old Caucasian male with

- NW V-VI, Class N
- Donor density of 92 FU/cm² occipital, 88 FU/cm² parietal, 80 FU/cm² temporal
- Hair diameter of ~54-60 microns

Treatment plan

1. Follicular Unit Extraction to attain an aesthetic reconstruction of the hairline and the midhead section.
2. Follicular Unit Extraction to restore the crown area.

Performed procedures

1. FUE (November 21, 2017) with 3531 FU
 - * 841 single hair FU
 - * 200 double hair FU
 - * 2490 triple hair FU

Parallel incisions in custom-sized blades technique (Cutting Edge blades of 0.7-0.85 mm).
Extraction performed with a 0.8 mm FUE punch with CIT Manual Punch Handle.

2. FUE (September 10, 2018) with 2678 FU
 - * 278 single hair FU
 - * 2400 double hair FU

Parallel incisions in custom-sized blades technique (Cutting Edge blades of 0.7-0.85 mm).
Extraction performed by WAW-system with a 0.85 mm serrated trumpet punch.

No microscopic preparation of the follicular unit grafts.
